# Status of Preparation of the College for SSR submission and checking and validating of documents

The following are the observation and feedback made:

# 1. College's Profile:

- a. IQAC Coordinator opens NAAC portal and show everyone present college' Profile for checking of errors and addition of anything when needed.
- b. Resource person made several correction and observation for instance Year 5 is not there because the college has not yet completed 12 months to qualify for the same. Year 1,2,3 and 4 will be database and Year 5 will be current.
- He instructed the members to confirm one case of student under SC category and those marked under OBC category
- d. To focus on the importance of OBE and to keep in mind that questions like what you do and what you plan to do will be asked

#### 2. Extended Profile

a. Extended Profile of the college was also shown and documents uploaded were checked. Soft copies and hard copies also were cross checked because both should be the same.

# 3. Criteria- 1 (Curricular Aspect)

- a. Points claimed under Effective Curriculum (1.1.1) should be finalized
- To provide the documents for Academic calendar, Lesson plan and Mentor and mentee to support the claims
- c. Resource Person also mentioned that some of the claims may be by default but out of the ten claims, at least five documents need to be there.
- d. One document will be for QNM and same document for QIM. He also mentioned that same document can be used in more than one places whenever needed.
- Activities of NSS and NCC under 1.3.1 to be removed and to be added to Extension Programme.
- Regarding Feedback analysis (1.4.1) Resource person informed that remedial measures and mentoring will be under Action Taken.
- g. Evidence of Action Taken for Teachers' Feedback will be FIP, RC, MPhil, PHD etc.

 Under 2.1.1 final admission list, admission abstract, approval of sanctioned seat and those received including Reservation seat document need to be added.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> day of NAAC Workshop was held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of March 2023 at 10.00 am in the Teachers' Common Room of the college. Dr. Samuel R. Lyndem, RUSA Consultant, Government of Meghalaya was the resource person for the said workshop.

The Principal welcomed the resource person Dr. Lyndem and all the faculties present in the workshop. He once again reminded the faculties of the deadline for the submission of Self Study Report (SSR) that is, the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 2023. He informed the faculties that checking of documents will be continued for each criterion in the session and whatever work is left to be completed must be done immediately within the time frame of seven days that is, the 9<sup>th</sup> of March 2023 for final submission of SSR. The principal then gave the time to Dr. Lyndem to start with the morning session.

The session started with the meeting of Criteria convenors and members and checking of the documents as per the recommended benchmark of the Affiliated College Manual. After thorough checking of the documents as per SOP requirements, various suggestions on Key Indicator and its metrics of each Criterion were given by Dr Lyndem.

The suggestions made to **Criterion 2- Teaching- Learning and Evaluation** was to include the current enrolled students of BA 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester students for Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS). The Head of the department should identify the regular students and select those students only. A selection of minimum 50% of students is required for SSS.

The suggestions put forth to **Criterion 3 – Research, Innovations and Extension**- was to make a completion certificate stating that Dr. Lyndem, RUSA consultant had conducted the NAAC Workshop, financially sponsored by RUSA as a NAAC preparation with RUSA logo/letter head on it.

The suggestions made to **Criterion 4- Infrastructure and Learning Resources** are to frame Library Policy with vision and mission of the policy. The vision of the policy should include the expectations of first 5- 7 years. The mission should include updating of library software of what is implementing now and then, Koha, library rules, budgeting, library auditing of books and upgradation of system.

To **Criterion 5- Student Support and Progression** the suggestions made were to include the Yoga events celebrated in the college along with report and photos. Anti-ragging policy, Library policy and 'Ong.telaigipa' Environmental Club policy should be included in Institution transparent mechanism. Percentage of placement of outgoing students and students progressing to higher education should be calculated from the first five years that is, from 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021, and 2021-22.

Dr. Lyndem then directed all the criterion convenors and members to procure the necessary documents and to make changes wherever required. Lyndem concluded the day session by stating that much of the criterion works have been completed but there are still some metrics that need to meet the requirements provided in the Benchmarks for the Q n Ms of Affiliated College Manual and directed the criterion convenors and members to work on the suggestions and changes that he has put forth on certain metrics.

The workshop concluded with a vote of thanks by the Principal to the resource person Dr. Lyndem for conducting such an informative session. The Principal also thanked the IQAC Cell and the faculties and also requested each criterion convenor and members to complete all the remaining work for the successful completion of SSS for NAAC Assessment and Accreditation.




