

Report on The EXPLORING THE BUSINESS ECOSYSTEM TOUR 2.0 TO NECBDC, BYRNIHAT

The E-Cell under the **Entrepreneurship & Vocational Committee** of Williamnagar Government College successfully organized a program called “**Exploring the Business Ecosystem Tour 2.0**” at the **North East Cane and Bamboo Development Council (NECBDC)** on 18th December, 2025 under the leadership of Shri Artis Lincton Sohshang, Convener of Entrepreneurship and Vocational Committee and Dr. Klewos Synshiang, Asst. Professor of Williamnagar Government College. The program was conducted with the objective of providing students with practical exposure to entrepreneurship, industrial operations, and the growing bamboo and cane-based business ecosystem in the North Eastern region of India. Students and faculty members participated enthusiastically in the educational visit, where they were introduced to various aspects of bamboo and cane processing, value addition, product development, marketing strategies, and sustainable business practices. The visit served as an enriching experience for the participants by exposing them to the functioning of an important regional organization that promotes skill development, innovation, and entrepreneurship in the bamboo sector.

The program commenced with the arrival of the participants at the NECBDC campus, where the officials warmly welcomed the delegation from Williamnagar Government College. An introductory session was conducted by Shri **S. Samanda Singh** who is a *Master Trainer* at NECBDC to familiarize the students with the history, objectives, and activities of the organization. The resource persons **Dr. Tilak Ch Bhuyan** who was the *Consultant* at the Institute, explained that NECBDC plays a vital role in promoting the bamboo and cane industry in the North Eastern states by providing training, technological support, market linkages, and entrepreneurship opportunities to local artisans and aspiring entrepreneurs.

During the interaction session, the students learned about the importance of bamboo as a sustainable and eco-friendly resource. The officials highlighted how bamboo-based enterprises contribute significantly to employment generation, rural livelihood development, and environmental conservation. Students were also informed about the increasing national and international demand for bamboo products and the opportunities available in sectors such as handicrafts, furniture making, construction materials, decorative items, and eco-friendly packaging solutions.

One of the most engaging parts of the tour was the guided visit to the production and training units of NECBDC by **Dr. Tilak Ch Bhuyan**. The participants observed the different stages involved in bamboo and cane processing, including treatment, cutting, shaping, polishing, and finishing. Demonstrations were provided on the use of modern machinery and tools that enhance the quality and durability of bamboo products. Students gained valuable insights into how traditional craftsmanship can be integrated with modern technology to create market-oriented products.

Sir H.P.K Singh a Manager Trainer of NECBDC also shared information regarding entrepreneurship development programs and vocational training initiatives conducted by NECBDC. Students were encouraged to consider self-employment and startup opportunities in the bamboo and handicraft sector. The interaction motivated many participants to think creatively about utilizing locally available resources for sustainable business ventures. The discussion emphasized the importance of innovation, branding, quality control, and marketing in establishing successful enterprises.

The educational tour proved to be highly informative and inspirational for the students. It provided them with firsthand knowledge of entrepreneurship practices and enhanced their understanding of the practical challenges and opportunities within the business environment. The program also helped in developing entrepreneurial awareness, leadership qualities, communication skills, and a sense of innovation among the participants.
