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

<b>POL-150 Indian Political System</b>	The paper will familiarize students with the dynamics of Indian Politics and enable them to understand both constitutional and the socio-economic dimensions of the Indian political system.
<b>POL-200 Introduction to International Politics</b>	Students will understand the key theories, concepts, and debates surrounding international relations. Students will acquire a comprehensive reading of the origin of International Relations and its mainstream theories and concepts.
<b>POL-201 Public Administration</b>	It will enable students to understand an overview of the discipline, the basic concepts, dimensions, perspectives, and approaches to Public Administration and familiarize themselves with contemporary interpretations for a deeper understanding of the subject.

<b>POL-253 Political Sociology</b>	This paper will enable the students to understand the societal factors that determine politics and vice versa and prepare them to take up and perform better in future administrative roles.
<b>POL - 300 Socialist Political Thought</b>	Students will be able to understand the evolution and development of political ideas that attempt to solve the problems arising from the crisis of capitalism and how relevant those are in the present times.
<b>POL - 301 State and Democracy in India</b>	It will familiarize students with the challenges to democracy and the role of the Indian State by focusing on some key determinants of democracy.
<b>POL - 302 Government and Politics in Northeast India</b>	Students will be able to understand the intricate interconnectedness of the historical narratives and distinctive socio-political structures of the region, ranging from traditional political institutions, colonial government and the post-independent constitutional framework and the various demands for autonomy by tribal groups, the inter-state disputes and the role of the political parties and pressure groups in the political processes.
<b>POL - 350 Modern Indian Political Thought</b>	The students will understand Indian political thought and its rich tradition of maintaining continuity. It will make the students aware of India's rich cultural, social, political and secular traditions through the select thinkers.
<b>POL - 351 Feminist Theory and Practice</b>	The student will be equipped with the foundational concepts and theories of Feminism. The student will understand the history and the importance of the women's movement for gender equality and create greater awareness about gender sensitization, gender equality, and the legal provisions for their remedy.
