Report on Mentor-Mentee conducted by the Department of Economics for the Academic Session 2023-2024 (Even Semester, 2024)

The Department of Economics conducted the mentor-mentee program for the even semester under the academic session 2023-24, as to motivate and assist students to perform better in subjects in whom they were found lacking behind and also to guide students in different aspects of academic/co-curricular activities.

Mentee Issues Raise:

1. Mentees from BA 2nd semester found the MDC paper Entrepreneurship interesting, however, the need for more field trip/practical classes/workshops were raised.
2. Students found the Indian Economy paper tough as they were not exposed to recent economic developmental activities (in terms of figures) in the country.
3. Students wanted to participate and experience other academic/co-curricular activities.
4. Students also raised the need for College uniform.


Issues Resolved:

1. To solve the issues raised by the mentees of BA 2nd semester regarding the Entrepreneurship paper, more workshop were conducted in the college, several known Entrepreneurs from PRIME were called as resource persons and selected students were taken for programs in Shillong under the PRIME. An important part of this paper was the achievement that is, setting up of E-Cell in the College.
2. To acquaint the mentees with problems and figures in the Indian Economy paper, journals, magazines were prescribed by the department which students can access



from the college library, so that they will be acquainted with the current affairs/development of the country. Discussions and debates were also conducted so that the students will be more familiar with the present situation of the country. Further, extra classes were taken from time to time depending on the need of different units of the course. Question papers were discussed as well answer scripts of Internal Tests and Assignments, in order to enable the students to understand their need for improvement.

3. With the setting up of the E-Cell in the College, students were encouraged to enroll themselves and to participate in various activities organized by E-Cell. Further, students were also encouraged to enroll themselves in NSS and NCC and to participate in various activities organized by the college.
4. The need for College uniform, which was one of the important issue raised by the mentees in general was considered and hence the College authority, decided that with the commencement of the new academic session 2024-25 uniform will be introduced as a part of institution.


Mentee Issues Raise:

1. Mentees from BA 1st semester have problem in solving math exercises in the MDC paper.
2. The need for extra classes was also raised by all mentees.
3. Students wanted to participate and experience other academic/co-curricular activities.
4. Students also raised the need for College uniform.

Issues Resolved:

1. To acquaint the mentees with basic topics of mathematics, for both BA 1st and BA 3rd semester, the topics were taught in a simplified manner using simple examples. Further re-evaluation was done by the mentor.
2. To resolve the problem of need for the extra classes by all mentees, extra classes for all papers were taken from time to time depending on the need of different units of the course.
3. Students were encouraged to enroll themselves in different clubs of the college like the Ong'telaigipa Environment club, NSS and NCC and to participate in various activities organized by these clubs and the college in general.

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4. The need for College uniform, which was one of the important issue raised by the mentees in general was taken into consideration and a committee was formed to look into the matter.
