- Multi-Disciplinary Courses (MDC): 1 paper
- Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): 1 paper
- Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): 1 paper

Smt. Eubina Sungoh further elaborated on the assessment criteria:

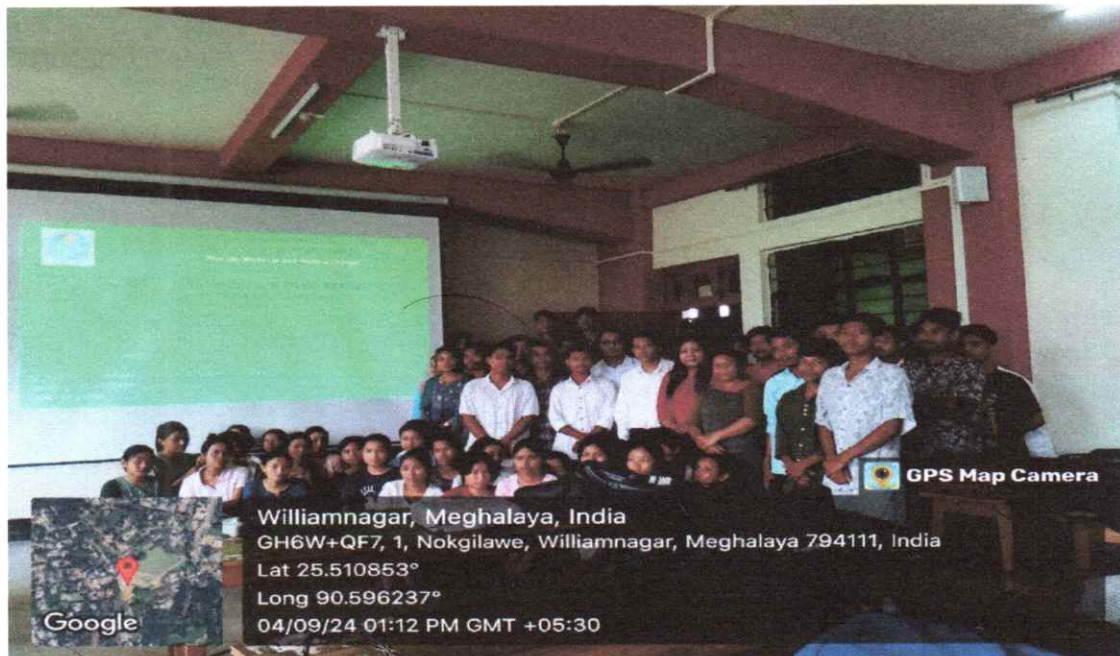
- 4-credit Courses: Internal assessment of 25 marks (comprising 10 marks for assignments and 15 marks for internal examinations) and an external examination of 75 marks.
- 3-credit Courses: Internal assessment of 19 marks and an external examination of 56 marks.

Dr. Antarwell Warjri, Assistant Professor of Political Science, provided valuable advice to the students. He encouraged them to engage actively with their studies, seek help when needed, and take full advantage of the resources and opportunities available within the department. Dr. Antarwell Warjri insights were aimed at motivating students to achieve their academic and personal goals.

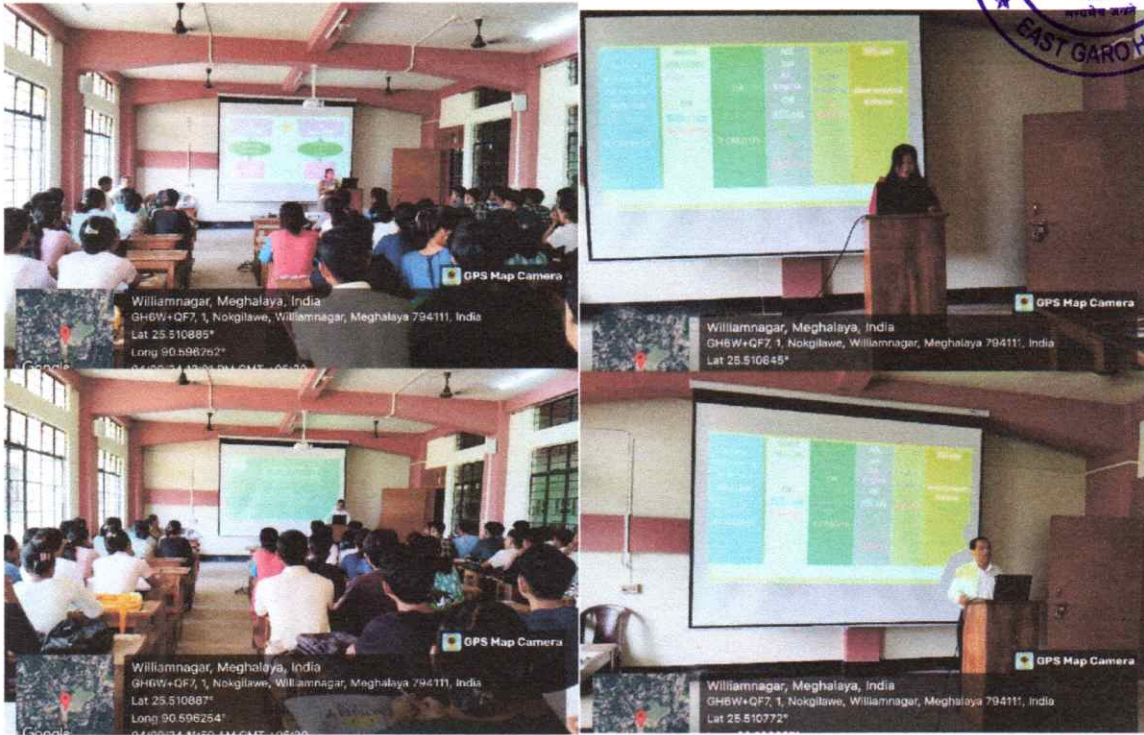
