1. Attempt any *five* of the following : 3×5=15

- (a) What mistake did Ferenze make regarding his treatment of Barabas and why?
- (b) What was the Cardinal's chief motivation for controlling the Duchess? Did he succeed?
- (c) Who was John de Stogumber? What caused him to repent in the play, *Saint Joan*?
- (d) Briefly comment on the similarities and differences of the two women characters in *Twelfth Night*.

- (e) How did the changes in Valentine and Ben's lives affect them at the end of *Love for Love*?
- (f) What was Jimmy's reaction to Helena's decision to stay back in the 2nd Act of the play, *Look Back in Anger*?

- 2. Explain the consequences of greed and selfishness in the play, *Love for Love*. 15
- 3. Critically examine the character of Joan in Shaw's play, *Saint Joan*. 15
- 4. Comment on the themes of greed and betrayal in *The Jew of Malta*. 15
- 5. Discuss William Shakespeare's use of disguise and mistaken identity as comic devices in the play, *Twelfth Night*. 15
- 6. Critically comment on Webster's *The Duchess of Malfi* as a revenge tragedy. 15
