





Report on

"Entrepreneurial Insight: A Journey of Creativity, Innovation & Inspiration"



Organized by E-Cell, Williamnagar Government College on the 29th August, 2024.











The workshop aimed to ignite the entrepreneurial spirit among students, equipping them with the knowledge and tools needed to navigate the world of startups and innovation. The event was designed to be a comprehensive experience, blending theoretical insights with practical applications, inspiring students to think creatively and pursue their entrepreneurial aspirations. A total of 77 students participated in the Workshop.

The primary objectives of the workshop are to:

- i. **Cultivate Entrepreneurial Mindset:** The workshop fostered an entrepreneurial mindset among students, encouraging them to think creatively and innovatively in solving real-world problems.
- ii. **Enhance Creativity and Innovation:** The workshop also provided students with the tools and techniques to enhance their creativity, enabling them to generate innovative ideas.
- iii. **Inspire and Motivate:** Local entrepreneurs of Meghalaya shared their success stories which inspired students, and guided them into the potential impact of entrepreneurship on society.
- iv. **Provide Practical Insights:** The workshop offered practical insights into the entrepreneurial journey, business model development and the challenges of starting a business.
- v. **Networking Opportunities:** The workshop created opportunities for students to network with like-minded peers, mentors, and the PRIME Team, fostering collaboration and partnerships.

Session 1 (Opening Session): Setting the Stage

The workshop kicked off with an opening session from Shri. Artis L Sohshang *(Convener, Entrepreneur & Vocation Committee, WGC)* which set the stage for the day's activities. The session introduced the theme of the workshop, outlining the objectives, and provided an overview of the agenda. Further, the session also introduced the entrepreneurs and the PRIME Team from Tura as resource persons for the programme.

Session 2: Understanding Entrepreneurship and Q&A Panel

In this session, local entrepreneurs shared their journey, highlighting the importance of creativity, innovation, and resilience in entrepreneurship. The speakers on this session comprised of (i) Smt. Senoritha M Sangma *(Founder of Senoritha Sangma Food Product,*

The session explored on:

- (i) **Ideas that turned into business:** Local entrepreneurs were given their allotted time to narrate/present their entrepreneurial journey.
- (ii) **Common Challenges:** They also discussed common challenges faced by entrepreneurs, such as funding, competition, and market entry.
- (iii) **Building Resilience:** They also shared the techniques for building resilience and staying motivated during tough times.
- (iv) **Mentorship and Support**: Entrepreneurs also highlighted on the importance of mentorship and how to seek out mentors who can guide the entrepreneurial journey.
- (v) Success stories: Entrepreneurs also shared their success stories and how much their business has impacted their lives.
- (vi) After each entrepreneur presents their journey, a Q & A panel was conducted to address the queries from the students.

Session 3: Felicitation of the First Student Entrepreneurs

In this session the first group of Student Entrepreneurs of Williamnagar Government College were felicitated by Shri. Rajiv K Marak *(Principal, Williamnagar Government College)*. Further, Dr. Cherik D D Sangma (*Joint-Coordinator E-Cell, WGC*) highlighted on the achievements of the first Student Entrepreneurs of the College, for not only being students but trailblazers for the student community of the College. Further, Dr. Cherik also encouraged them to stay committed to learning, adapting, and growing.

Closing Session: The Way Forward






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
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




















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
