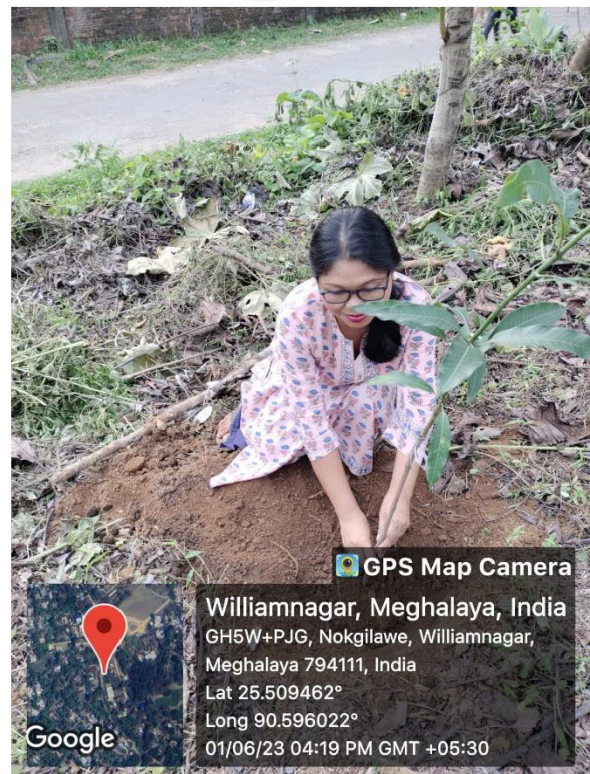
The Ong'telaigipa Environmental Club, Williamnagar Govt. College celebrated this year's World Environment Day through a series of Three-day events. Furthermore, this year also marks the 50th Anniversary of the World Environment Day celebration, therefore the activities adopted by the Ong'telaigipa Environmental Club was to ensure that the Institution raises awareness and put to the fore the pressing issues regarding plastic pollution.


Day 1 of celebration was held on the **1st June, 2023 with a Tree Planation Activity** organized by the Environmental Club in collaboration with the EBSB Committee of the Institution. A total of 45 Tree saplings were planted in the college premises, comprising of fruit-yielding plant species of the Garo Hills region. These tree species are essential in ensuring the ecological balance in the college campus. The objective of the Tree Plantation Activity was to educate people on the significance of local species of flora and fauna in the ecological balance by filling a niche that no other species could. These species are also affected by deforestation and environmental pollution, which would have catastrophic effects on the local environment and climate.

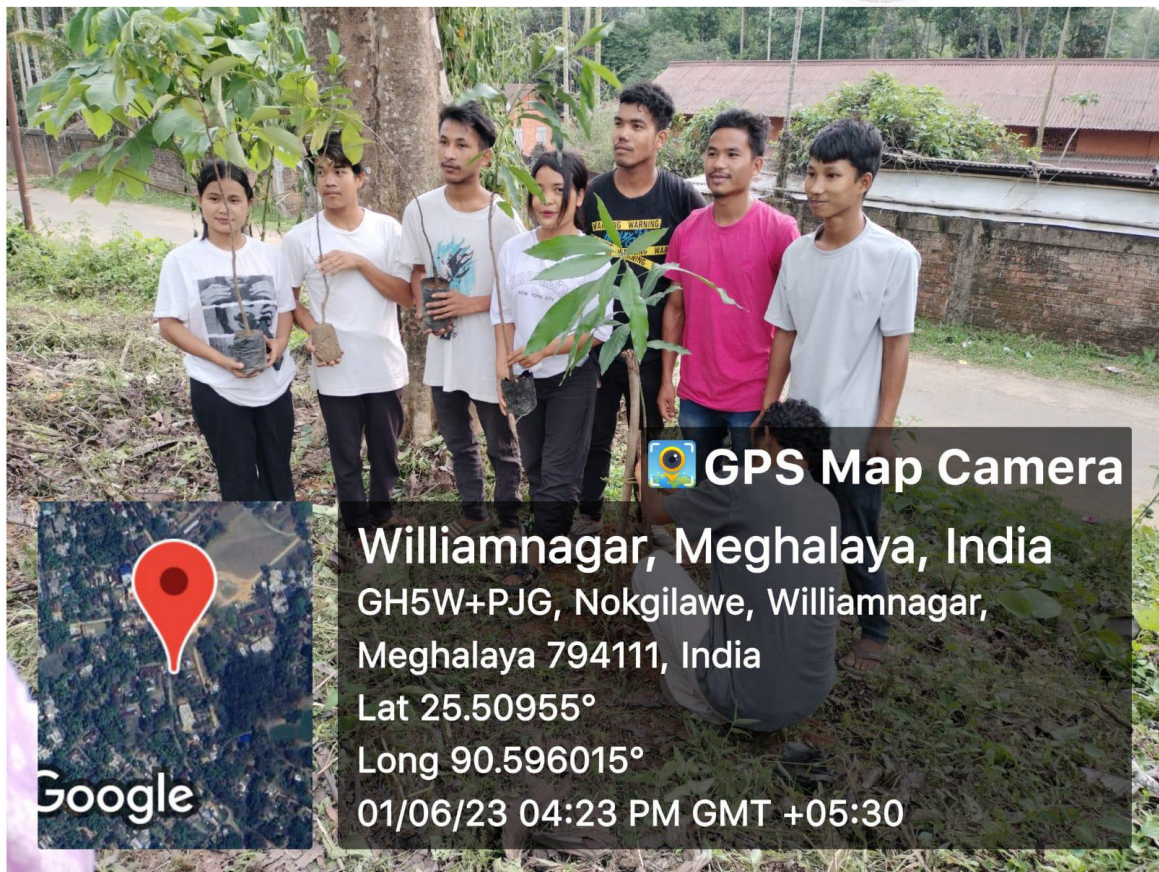

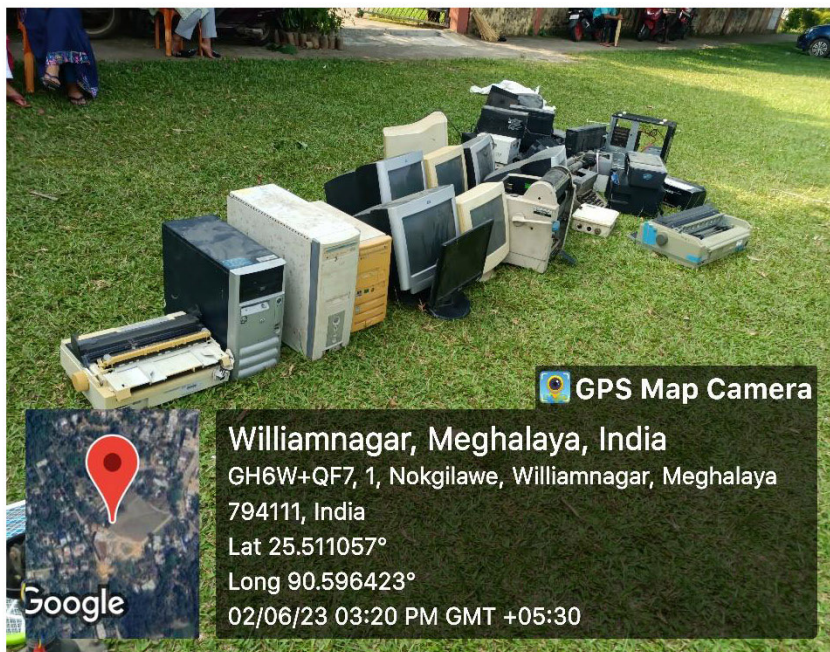

Day 2 of celebration was held on the **2nd June, 2023 with an E-waste Recycling Activity** organized by the Environmental Club of the Institution. The faculties and students of the Institution were encouraged to bring their electronic waste to the college campus and the e-waste were collected and delivered to J S Enterprise, an E-waste collection unit. A total of 249 Kgs of e-waste was generated by the Institution, comprising of computers, printers, photocopy machines, ceiling fans, electric kettle, computer accessories, LED bulbs, miscellaneous items, etc. The objective of encouraging e-waste collection is to accentuate the significance of recycling all kinds of electronic wastes, by tackling both issues of environmental pollution and public health. Electronic devices are comprised of toxic substances and heavy metals, which if disposed carelessly, not only cause environmental pollution, but has significant impact on the health of people. Therefore, the initiative of E-waste Recycling has been adopted as a part of this year's celebration of the World Environment Day in order to put into practice the proper disposal of not only Plastic wastes, but also electronic wastes, which are made with a variety of materials such as metals and plastics.

Day 3 of celebration was held on the **5th June, 2023 with the World Environment Day celebration**. The Programme was held at 1 p.m. in the presence of the Principal, Shri. Rajiv K Marak; the Convener and Members of the 'Ong'telaigipa' Environmental Club; the faculties; students and student members of WGC Students' Union; and the non-teaching staff of Williamnagar Government College. A Keynote Address was also given by the Principal on the message of the World Environment Day, 2022 theme, followed by the collection of plastic bottles, old items such as shoes and other recyclable items. 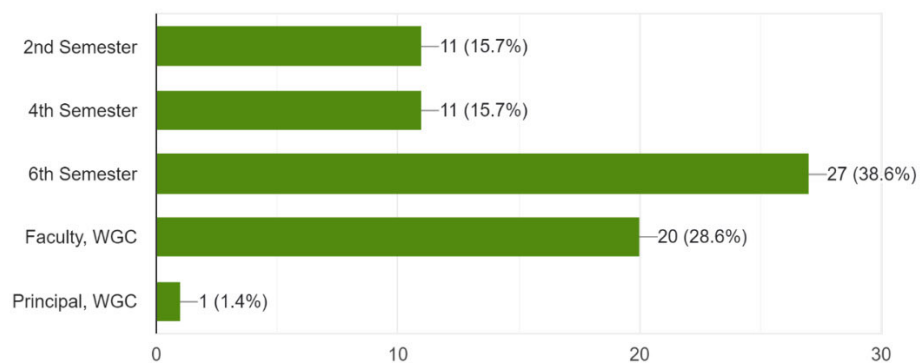
