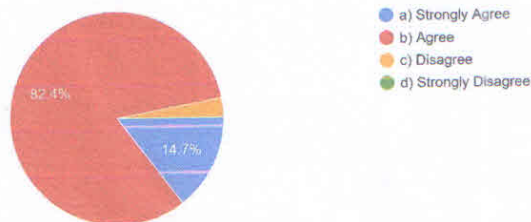

The closed-ended questions employ a structured format, often using multi-choices options, focusing on aspects such as course content, teaching effectiveness, classroom environment, and availability of resources.

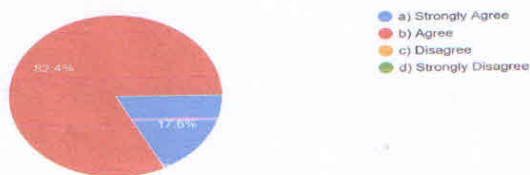
The open-ended questions allow students to share specific observations, constructive criticisms, and suggestions, fostering a deeper understanding of their experiences and expectations.

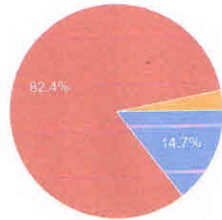

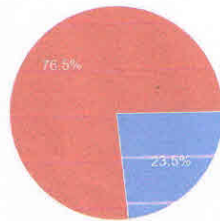

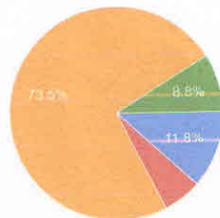

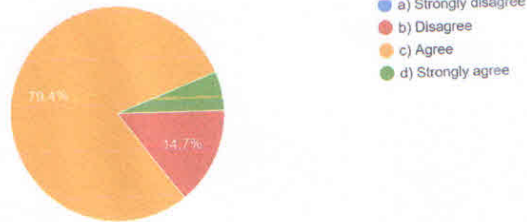

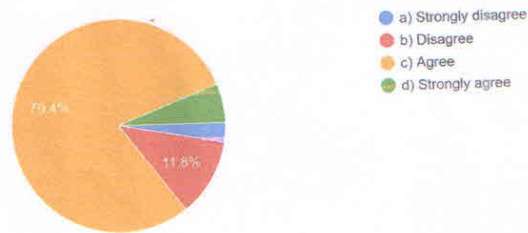

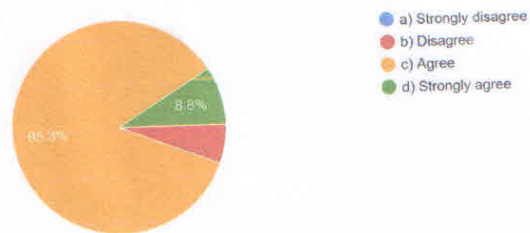
