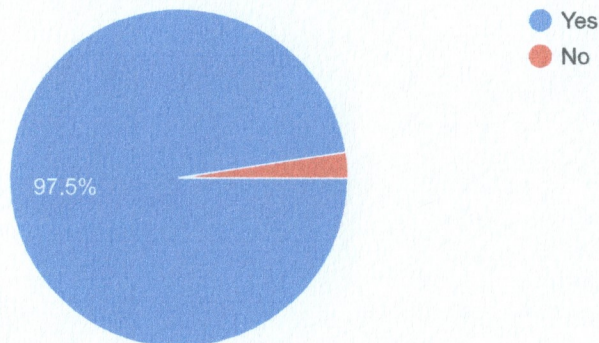

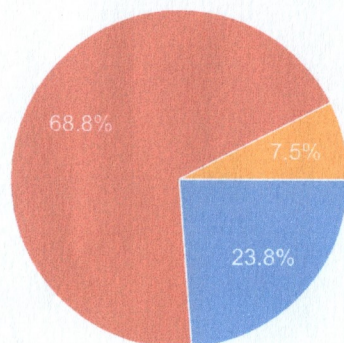

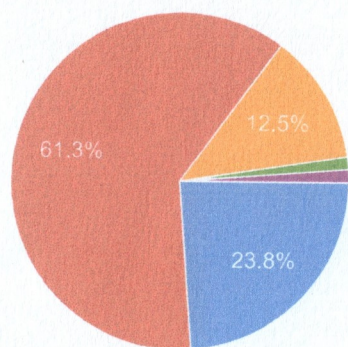

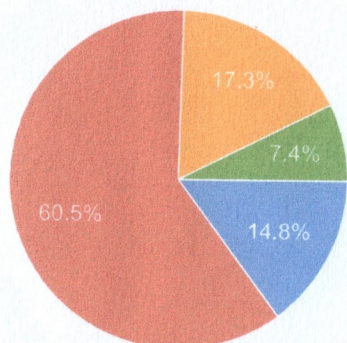

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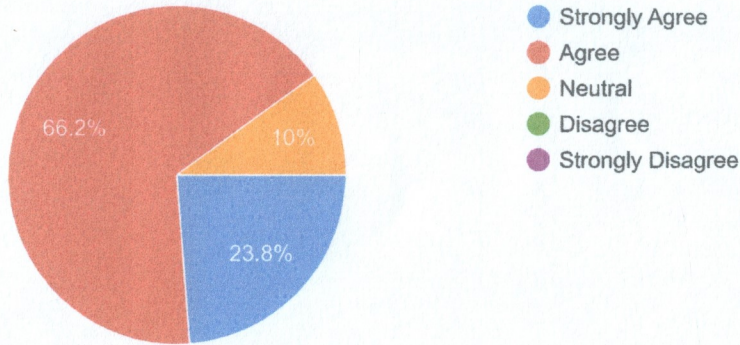

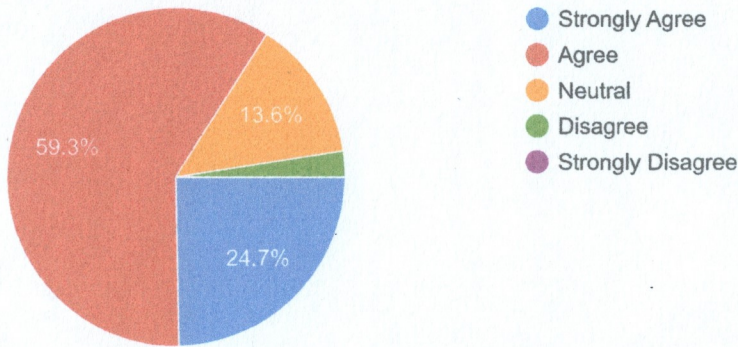

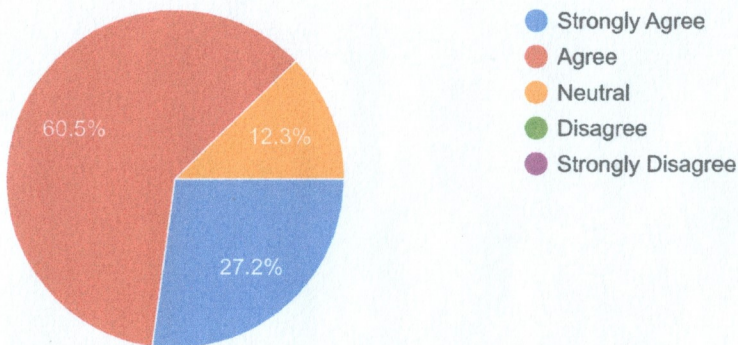

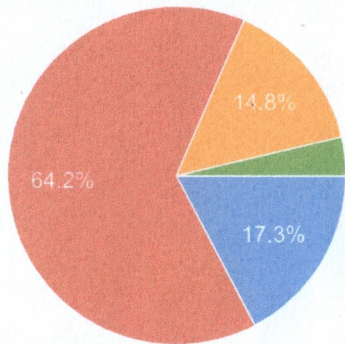

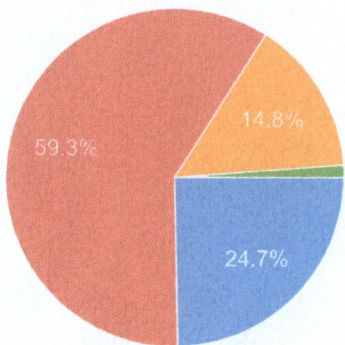

ANALYSIS REPORT OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK ON TEACHING-LEARNING 2023



The students' response on Teaching-learning was collected and analysed through statistical tools. The data and analysis provided useful information to understand the students' expectations and at the same time to help monitor improvement and planning in teaching-learning process by involving students.

Feedback Analysis

1. In response to the syllabus of the course being need-based & provided adequate knowledge on the subject majority of the students agree (68.8%) & strongly agree (23.8%) & some remained neutral (7.5%) and disagree to the course being need-based & provide knowledge and the subject.
2. Majority of the students agree (65.4%) & strongly agree (24.7%) while some students responded neutral & disagree to the teachers being well prepared & knowledgeable with the course content/lesson the teachers teach with in the class.
3. Most of the students agree (61.3%) & strongly agree (23.8%) to the course objectives being realised through effectively delivery of content/topics of curricular through meaningful teaching learning process. However, some students remained neutral (12.5%) and disagree to the question.
4. Majority of the students agree (60.5%) and strongly agree (14.8%) to teachers using student centric method such as group discussion, participative learning and student presentation for enhancing learning experience. However, some students remained neutral (17.3%) and disagree (7.4%) to the use of the method.
5. Most of the student agree (66.2%) and strongly agree (23.8%) while some remained neutral (10%) to the teaching, assignments, examinations and evaluation complimenting each other.
6. Majority of the students agree (59.3%) and strongly agree (24.7%) while some remained neutral (13.6%) and disagree to teachers providing multiple opportunities to learn and develop.
7. Majority of the students agree (60.5%) and strongly agree (27.2%) while some students remained neutral (12.3%) to teachers encouraging the students to participate in extra-curricular activities.
8. In response to teachers made efforts to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the Teaching-learning process, majority of the students agree (65.4%) and strongly agree (17.3%) while some remained neutral (17.3%) to the question.
9. Majority of the students agree (64.2%) and strongly agree (17.3%) while some remained neutral (14.8%) and disagree to the efforts made by teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the students ready for the world of work.
10. Majority of the students agree (59.3%) and strongly agree (24.7%) while some students remained neutral (14.8%) to the teachers having taught a lesson on how to bring all round development in the students.

Overall, most of the students are satisfied with the quality of Teaching-Learning process and approach of the teachers. However, the analysis of the feedback of the students indicates that some

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of the students have remained neutral and are not able to understand the teaching-learning process adopted in the classroom.



Remedial Measures

Some remedial measures are taken up by the Department to improve the teaching-learning process in the classroom. By embracing these remedies students are provided with a multifaceted platform to enhance the skills, knowledge and overall growth of their personality.

1. The department continue to encourage and motivate the students to actively participate in extracurricular activities both within and beyond the institution's boundaries.
2. The continued adoption of mentor mentee meetings enriches the educational journey by offering personalised guidance and support to the students.
3. ICT tools are being used for department programmes like Induction/Orientation by providing variety in the presentation of content such as PowerPoint presentation by adding images, art, chart, music and videos to it.
4. Communication with students through WhatsApp groups relating to academic matters for all semesters is also practiced.
5. Film screening and documentary connected to literature is also organized to built interests and provide a visual aid to understand the concepts of drama and novel better.

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
